If this can even be supplied with the environmental issues of Coral Bay. We have the best Dinghy dock on St John due to and a big Thank You to our local Community of Coral Bay. The amount of money granted seems to be of the amount for a marina of this size. I always tell people the muscles in cheeks hurt from the smiles and giggles I get every day living and working in Coral Bay. Please do not take this joyous life I have chosen away from us.

Look out they will be asking you for permits to build an airport next. Mega Yacht people will not want to take a ferry or drive across St John to get to their Private Yacht. That is why they will keep using Havensight. And that is way under used as it is.
