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# The St. John Marina

The developers of The St. John Marina have met directly with WAPA's head of operations on St. John, Winston Smith, and WAPA engineer Lowell Fahie. Meetings have been held on site to discuss the load requirements and infrastructure necessary for the project.

The St. John Marina is requesting 1.5 megawatts during peak season and has submitted the preliminary Load Requirement Sheet requested by WAPA. This Load Requirement Sheet itemizes the electrical requirements for the project and allows WAPA to run the necessary calculations needed to make sure that the project will have the appropriate amount of power as required by the marina vessels and the upland businesses.

WAPA currently has three-phase power at the site of The St. John Marina which is well over the amount required for operations. Distribution is to be facilitated by a series of transformers and switch gear to supply multiple voltages which include 480 three-phase, 220 single-phase, and three phase 110 GFI.

WAPA has informed us that the three-phase power that is currently on site will supply The St. John Marina with more than enough power to support the demand, even in peak season. WAPA assures us that our use of the three-phase power will not detract from the single-phase power that the community of Coral Bay uses.




