MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Sirius Marina, Coral Bay, St. John – Meeting and Site Visit with Wiliam McComb.

1. On October 2, 2015, a meeting and site visit were conducted with Mr. William McComb (Agent), representative of T-Rex, St. John, LLC, who is the permit applicant for the proposed Sirius Marina, Coral Bay, St. John, U.S. Virgin Islands.
2. The meeting was held at the proposed location for the Sirius Marina. A site visit / reconnaissance of the proposed project areas followed the meeting.
3. Participants for the Corps included Kelly Finch (South Permits Branch Chief) and me.
4. During the meeting and site visit Mr. McComb explained to the Corps details about the project, particularly the proposed work in waters of the U.S., including dredging, removal of mangrove areas and discharge of fill material in mangrove wetlands and open waters of Coral Bay. Mr. McComb also provided information regarding recent modifications to the project that have taken place after the Corps issued the latest request for information necessary for a complete permit application.
5. Mr. McComb explained that a response to the Corps request for information, with details about the most recent project modifications would be submitted to the next in the following weeks.
